Subject: BCAR-147 Approved Organisations

1. Purpose

This advisory circular (AC) provides information on the BCAR-147 approved organisation.

2. Background

The BCAA has published and implemented the BCAR-147 regulations. In line with it, BCAA has approved the **JRN Institute of Aviation Technology** (Indian Institute of Aeronautics) based in New Delhi, India as the first BCAR-147 approval holder to conduct the basic aircraft maintenance course and the module examinations for the BCAR-66 license. The institute also holds EASA part-147 approval.

The institute only holds the privileges of **B1.1 Aeroplane Turbine** and conducts the basic AME course and examinations on this license category.
